### **RULES**

- Attendance is Mandatory. If you know that the child will be more than 5 minutes late, a call to the coordinators at the Masjid (201-833-2162) or an email to [education@nidaulislam.org](mailto:education@nidaulislam.org), no later than 6:35 pm is required to inform that the child will be late. Same rule applies if your child will be absent for the day.
- Parents are expected to ensure that their children arrive and are picked up on time
- Parents are requested to join Prayers. This will encourage the children as well.
- Please drop off and pick up your children from masjid's parking lot, not the street.
- Students should maintain discipline in the classroom. They are expected to conduct themselves in a proper, responsible and Islamic manner - respecting their teachers and other adults, their fellow students and all property.

### **DRESS CODE**

- Boys are required to wear a kufi (cap), loose pants and long shirts. A Thob is preferred. No shorts.
- Girls are required to wear a Hijab, Knee length top and loose pants. An Abaya is preferred.
